Grilling Safety Tips:

- Propane and charcoal BBQ grills should only be used outdoors.
- The grill should be placed well away from the home, deck railings and out from under eaves and overhanging branches.
- Keep children and pets away from the grill area.
- Keep your grill clean by removing grease or fat buildup from the grills and in trays below the grill.
- Never leave your grill unattended.

Before you use your grill:

- Check the major connection points between the gas (propane) tank hose and the regulator and cylinder, and where the hose connects to the burners. Tighten if loose.
- Check the gas (propane) tank hose for the potential (gas) leaks. To do that:
 - Apply a light soap and water solution to the hose using a brush or spray bottle.

To keep you and your family safe while grilling, follow these general guidelines.

- Turn the propane tank on. If there is a gas leak, the propane will release bubbles around the hose (big enough to see).
- If there are no bubbles, your grill is safe to use.
- If there are bubbles, turn off the tank and check connections, then have your grill serviced by a professional before using it again.
- If the leak doesn't stop, call the fire department immediately.



When the grill is on:

- As you are cooking, if you smell gas, turn off the gas tank and burners.
- If the leak stops immediately, get the grill serviced by a professional before using it again.
- If the smell continues, move away from the grill and call the fire department immediately. Do not move the grill.

GRILLED Corn-on-the-Cob

How to grill juicy, tender, grilled corn-on-the-cob! Grill fresh corn cobs in their husks on direct high heat.



COOK TIME: 20 minutes

YIELD: Serves 4

INGREDIENTS:

- 4 ears fresh corn, in their husks
- Butter (or an herb butter)

METHOD:

Prepare your grill, gas or charcoal, with direct, high heat, about 550°F. The corn husks will protect the corn from burning or drying out while it is on the hot grill. If you want a bit of char on your corn, peel off a few of the outer layers of the corn husks first, before grilling.

Place the corn in their husks on the hot grill. Cover the grill. Turn the corn occasionally, until the husks are completely blackened and charred on all sides, about 15 to 20 minutes.

Remove the corn from the grill. Let them sit for 5 minutes or until cool enough to handle. Remove the silks and charred husks from the corn. If you need to, use a damp towel to protect your hands from any sharp edges from the charred corn husks as you peel them off.

Serve with butter. (Or you can sprinkle with a little chili powder, cotija cheese, and some lime juice for a Mexican twist.) **ENJOY!**

Call Before You Dig!

It's important that anyone who is excavating must know where all buried utility lines are located.



**Know what's below.
Call before you dig.**

Follow these steps:

1. Call Kerschner's Gas Service, Inc. so we may locate your propane gas lines.
2. Contact Diggers Hotline to locate all other buried utility lines. IT'S THE LAW.
3. Wait the State's required time (at least 3 working days) before you begin to dig.
4. After underground lines have been located, respect the paint markings or flags and dig with care around them.
