Call before you dig.**

Call Before You Dig! It's important that anyone who is excavating must know where all buried utility lines are located. Follow these steps:

1. Call Kerschner's Gas Service, Inc. so we may locate your propane gas lines.
2. Contact Diggers Hotline to locate all other buried utility lines. IT'S THE LAW.
3. Wait the State's required time (at least 3 working days) before you begin to dig.
4. After underground lines have been located, respect the paint markings or flags and dig with care around them.



IS THAT SMELL PROPANE?

Propane smells like rotten eggs, a skunk's spray, or a dead animal. Some people may have difficulty smelling propane due to their age (older people may have a less sensitive sense of smell); a medical condition; or the effects of medication, alcohol, tobacco, or drugs. Consider purchasing a propane gas detector as an additional measure of security.

ODOR FADE is an unintended reduction in the concentration of the odor of propane, making it more difficult to smell. Although rare, several situations can cause odor to fade:

- The presence of air, water, or rust in a propane tank or cylinder
- The passage of leaking propane through the soil

Since there is a possibility of odor fade or problems with your sense of smell, you should respond immediately to even a faint odor of gas.

Why the Septic Tanks Needs Pumping Periodically

Most of the solid waste that is in your septic tank is broken down by bacteria. The rest remains in the tank and builds up in sludge and scum layers. Consequently, your septic tank must be pumped out regularly. Otherwise, solids would eventually fill the tank and wash out into the leachfield. This is detrimental to the overall health and longevity of your system.

CAUTION: If solids do overflow from the septic tank into the leachfield, they will prematurely clog the soil pores. Pumping out the tank at this point will not restore the system. The most likely scenario would be installing a new leachfield in a different area, which can be expensive.

Having your system pumped by Kerschner's every two or three years can help improve the longevity and keep your system working properly. If you have high water usage or a garbage disposal, you may wish to have your inspections be more frequent.

Is Your Regulator Getting Old and Tired?

The LP gas regulator on your house delivers the needed pressures for your appliances to operate properly and efficiently. As your gas system ages it is recommended by the manufacturers that your gas regulator(s) be replaced. Many older models recommend changing out regulators after 15 years of service with newer guidelines specifying up to 30 years for newer models. We encourage you to call to schedule preventative service anytime you feel your regulators are getting old or your propane system needs service.
